



Dear Parents,

We wish to welcome, both you and your little one, to our junior classes.

Dumbo (3months – 1year) and Bambi (1 to 2 years)

We hope and trust that you will be satisfied with our service. Should you wish to discuss anything, please do not hesitate to make an appointment, or give me a call directly.

For your stay in these classes, we wish that you note the following (**All things must be clearly marked such as clothing, bedding, bottles, lids, foods. etc.**)



Either an Assistant or teacher will be in the class from 6:30 until 17:00.



We feel strongly about your little one's development and stimulation - we therefore do not administer any vitamins (immune boosters) nor do we nebulize babies unless we have a written letter from a doctor encouraging a third nebulize, which will be done at lunch time.



The aforementioned applies for medication as well: prescribed medication may be given by the Class teacher at lunch time with written permission from the parent. **Please give morning and evening servings at home.**



TAKE NOTE: we will request that you to fetch your little one and observe him/her for **at least 24 hours** in the following cases: **Vomiting, an upset tummy (4 dirty nappies and more), and a temperature that is above 38 degrees or any symptoms that indicate that your child has a contagious illness.**

The following must please be brought to school daily



At least 3-4 sets of clean clothing (as well as a warm set)



Extra blanket.



**Bottles with the correct amount of water in plus the measured-out formula, for the day
(Plus, an extra one please for hot days)**



5 disposable nappies.



Wet Wipes.



Baby Bum cream.



Nappy bag.

The feedings in the Bambi Room are as follows:



Breakfast until 08:00, a snack between 10:00 and 11:00, lunch at 11:45 and a further snack at 15:00.

Gripe water, teething-gel, a juice bottle, and a bib for everyday of the week will also be appreciated.



Dirty clothing and items will be sent home in a plastic bag. (please provide a plastic bag daily) and we request that you please check your child's bag daily.



Reports go out twice a year for Babies 6 months and older. (2nd term and 4th term).

No reports can be written for children who have not been in our school at least two months prior to assessments.



Dumbo Parents: When your little one starts school, please pack in a comfort item as well (something with a familiar smell from home) to keep them at ease the first few days.
